Bird has also held several regional management positions in marketing and communications with Motorola Electronics' Asia Pacific region and owned a communications and brand consultancy in Asia. She began her career in Toronto with J. Walter Thompson, a global brand communications company.

Bird holds a master of arts degree in communication management and a doctorate in communication from the University of South Australia. She is a regular speaker on communication, change management, and public relations measurement, and she's been honored twice with communication leadership awards from the International Association of Business Communicators (IABC) and the Public Relations Society of America (PRSA). In 2004, Bird was named Corporate PR Professional of the Year by *PR News*, a leading public relations news magazine. Bird is vice chair of the International Association of Business Communicators (IABC), a trustee of its research foundation, and an accredited business communicator via IABC's professional credential program.
