



FILMMAKER DAVID GORDON GREEN TO INTRODUCE LATEST FILM *SNOW ANGELS* AT WEXNER CENTER

CRITICALLY ACCLAIMED DRAMA MAKING ITS LOCAL DEBUT IN ONE-NIGHT-ONLY SCREENING

Critically acclaimed filmmaker **David Gordon Green** comes to the Wexner Center **Friday, March 28** at 7 pm to introduce [*Snow Angels*](#), his latest film. With an ensemble cast that includes Sam Rockwell, Kate Beckinsale, Griffin Dunne, Amy Sedaris, and Nicky Katt, *Snow Angels* was one of the most buzzed-about films at the 2007 Sundance Film Festival. Snow Angels, Green's fourth feature and first adaptation (of a novel by Stewart O'Nan), tells two stories of love and loss converging in a wintry Pennsylvania small town. Green leavens the tragic tone with humorous touches and his trademark lyricism to create a remarkably soulful movie. *Variety* called it "emotionally harrowing and gentle by turns...[a] well-acted winter's tale."

Since the appearance of his debut film *George Washington* in 2000, David Gordon Green has cemented his reputation as one of the most talented and distinctive American independent filmmakers to emerge in the past decade and was called "the most artful of film masters" by *IndieWire*. His other work includes *All the Real Girls*, *Undertow* (which screened at the Wex as part of the Secret Cinema series in 2004), and the upcoming Judd Apatow-produced *The Pineapple Express*, a marked departure from his independent roots to a major-studio production.

A mecca for film fans and aficionados in Columbus and the region, the Wexner Center presents premieres, visiting filmmakers, and the best in international and independent cinema year-round in its state-of-the-art theater. Just this year the Center has hosted visits from producer Christine Vachon, Tom Kalin, and Gus Van Sant.
