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**BRITISH ELECTRO BAND BROADCAST AND LO-FI MUSICIAN  
IRON AND WINE AT THE WEXNER CENTER**

U.K. electro band **Broadcast** and neo-folk artist **Iron and Wine** perform in the Wexner Center Performance Space on Tuesday, **October 21 at 9 pm** in a show recently added to the Wexner Center's concert season. Broadcast underscores the ethereal vocals of Trish Keenan with spiky synth lines, buzzing drones, and sounds rooted in sixties' psychedelic pop. With a sound often compared to Stereolab, Broadcast has received rave reviews for its recent album *HaHa Sound* on Warp Records. "[*HaHa Sound*] finds beauty and fascination in the tussle between melody and rhythm," wrote *Pitchfork*.
