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**WEXNER CENTER ACCEPTING ENTRIES THROUGH MARCH 22
FOR 7th ANNUAL OHIO SHORT FILM & VIDEO SHOWCASE**

The Wexner Center is now accepting entries for its seventh annual **Ohio Short Film & Video Showcase**, to be held Saturday, May 11, 2002 at 7 pm in the Wexner Center Film/Video Theater. **The deadline for entries is Friday, March 22.**

Pieces must be independently produced, no longer than 20 minutes, and produced in Ohio within the last 18 months. Entries must be submitted on ½-inch videotape. However, any format of film or video may be screened at the Showcase. Only one entry per person will be accepted. Works submitted to previous Showcases will not be accepted.

The Showcase provides Ohio's film and video artists a chance to show their work in a theater in front of an audience. Last year's capacity crowd watched 22 short works by artists from Columbus, Athens, Cleveland, Dayton, and Yellow Springs, among other cities.
