## **WEXNER CENTER'S 2002-03 EXHIBITIONS ANNOUNCED**

### ***ALL EXHIBITIONS GOING OFF-SITE DURING GALLERY RENOVATIONS***

In its 2002-03 season, the Wexner Center for the Arts will present exhibitions downtown for the first time in its history while the Center galleries are undergoing renovations. The downtown exhibitions are:

- ***From Pop to Now: Selections from the Sonnabend Collection***, featuring works by some of the most celebrated artists of the 20th century, from Andy Warhol to Jeff Koons, at The Belmont Building in the Arena District, November 3-February 2, 2003.
- ***Away from Home***, showcasing projects by emerging artists from around the world on the themes of home, travel, and sense of place, at Columbus College of Art & Design, February 1-April 20, 2003.
- ***Supernova<sup>3</sup>***, three installations by Hiro Yamagata featuring lasers, lights, and mirrored cubes, at COSI Columbus, May 3-September 1, 2003.

Also on view during the season is the outdoor public art project ***Lawrence Weiner: Until It Is***, which features enigmatic text embedded into a campus walkway at Mirror Lake Hollow at The Ohio State University, on view September 2002-July 2004.
