

## MAGICAL CANADIAN DANCE COMPANY PERFORMS FOR KIDS

Canada's <u>Sursaut compagnie de danse</u> will perform the scenic and poetic dance production *At Nightfall* in the Wexner Center's Mershon Auditorium **April 24–25**. The show connects fantasy with reality in the magical space between day and night; crazy, tender, tipsy, or delicate, the nocturnal dances of a tiny people include turning, jumping, and frolicking in total abandon. The elusive beauty and antic character of the miniature people exercise an undeniable charm and transforming power on Auguste, a timid and hardworking shoemaker who ventures into their Water Forest and learns to
