## The Wexner Center for the Arts Education Department Museum Education Fellows Program

The Wexner Center for the Arts Education Department is now accepting applications for its Museum Education Fellows Program. This program is designed to provide the opportunity for participants to gain an increased depth of knowledge about museum, particularly gallery-based, education practices.

Participants will develop their gallery teaching practice, will explore the use of social media in creating department "stories," and will gain insight into the practical mechanics and logistics of running programs. In addition, each fellow will be encouraged to delve into a related topic of particular interest to her or him.

The duration of the fellowship can span two or three semesters. Fellowships spanning two semesters must take place during the autumn and spring sessions. Summer is optional. Fellows will receive a stipend commensurate with the number of agreed upon semesters.

## **Eligibility:**

Participants may be enrolled in a university program, recently graduated, or shifting toward a museum career. Participation is not limited to OSU students. Priority will be given to individuals who are participating in or have completed the Wexner Center's docent program training.

Participants must have flexibility in their schedules to work with students in the gallery space during some weekday mornings (Tuesday–Friday). The schedule is flexible. On average, the fellow would be expected to teach in the galleries for 2–3 morning hours each week.

Participants will be working with minors and will be required to pass a background check.
